

Automatically fix broken links in Microsoft Access files with the newest release of *LinkFixerPlus!*

This newest release adds to *LinkFixerPlus'* current ability to move and rename Excel, Word, PowerPoint, HTML, AutoCAD, InDesign, PageMaker and Windows shortcut files without causing broken links.

IT professionals who are tasked with moving end-users' Microsoft Access files when conducting data migrations due to server consolidations, server name changes, path name changes or folder reorganizations, must also contend with the problem of ensuring that links contained within these files are not broken as a result of the move.

This is the problem that LinkTek's patent-pending product, *LinkFixerPlus for Microsoft Access* solves. It has been designed so that IT professionals can automate the reporting, management and repair of links in Microsoft Access files so they won't have to worry about broken links as a result of files being moved or renamed.

LinkFixerPlus for Access gives Microsoft Access users the ability to:

* Rename or move Microsoft Access files, and the files they link to, in batch, using sophisticated rename rules, without causing broken links in the Microsoft Access files.

- * Perform global search and replace operations on filenames contained in links, in large batches of Access files, with a single command.

- * Generate a broken link report listing all Microsoft Access files containing broken links, so they can be fixed before causing problems.

- * Generate a regular report listing each Microsoft Access file followed by a list of the files it links to.

- * Generate a cross-reference report listing each Microsoft Access file followed by a list of all the files that point to it.

- * Safeguard links in Microsoft Access files, allowing them to be repaired when they become broken due to files being moved or renamed.

- * Fix broken links in safeguarded Microsoft Access files totally automatically.

- * Report whether a file is being pointed to by any Microsoft Access file anywhere on a user's system, thereby letting the user know whether the file is safe to delete, rename or move.

LinkFixerPlus is the first software application that can fix broken links automatically when files or folders are moved or renamed. Using patent-pending technology, *LinkFixerPlus* helps eliminate the time-consuming and tedious process of manually finding and fixing broken links. Additionally, *LinkFixerPlus* can create a variety of

detailed reports, in Comma Separated Value (CSV) or HTML formats, showing all of the links contained within files, including any broken links.

First introduced at the 2002 Internet World convention in New York City, *LinkFixerPlus* won the Best of Show award in the design category.
