

Move and rename Microsoft PowerPoint 2007 files without causing broken links using new version of *LinkFixerPlus*.

Once safeguarded, *LinkFixerPlus* can repair broken links no matter what software or method was used to move, rename, migrate or reorganize them. Using patented technology, *LinkFixerPlus* helps eliminate the time-consuming and tedious process of manually finding and fixing broken links in PowerPoint files and in many other types of files.
